Strategies for Understanding and Coping with Children's Educational and Social Needs

The SUCCESS Program is an 8-week group-based behavioral program focused on teaching parents and children skills for managing attention and behavior and promoting academic success.

Parents will learn to apply strategies for managing common attention and behavior concerns in the home setting, including tools for supporting homework and home learning.

Children will receive small-group based homework help and will learn skills to support learning and academic productivity.

A behavior modification system will be implemented throughout the program to motivate appropriate, on-task behavior and academic skill practice.



